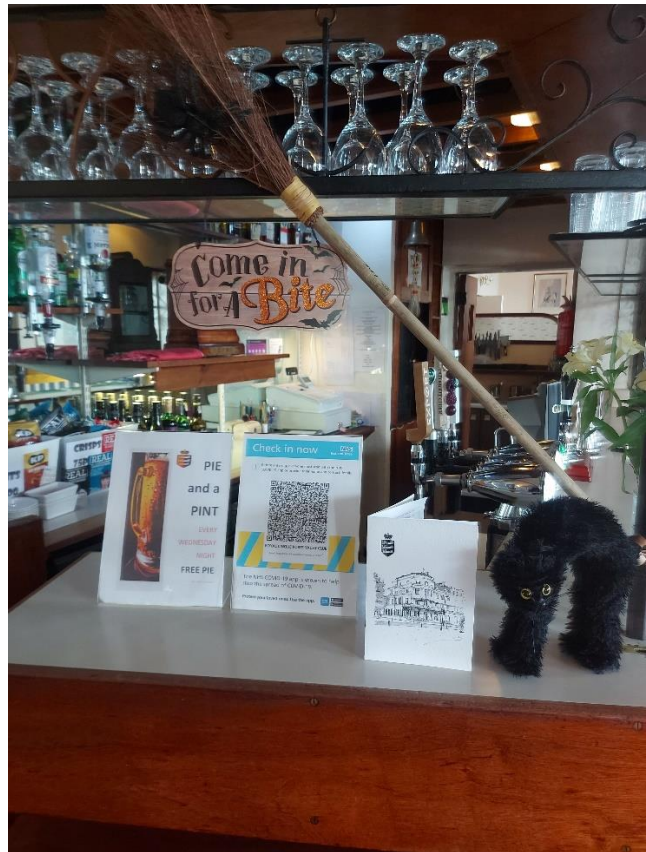
The free pies on Wednesday night are fantastic. We all enjoyed these last week before our committee meeting.
